Public Notice- Potential for Heavy Rainfall

Attention Property Owners:

There is the potential for heavy rainfall in the coming days, which may lead to increased water levels, localized flooding, and excess runoff in low-lying areas. Property owners are encouraged to take proactive measures to minimize potential water damage.

Residents can help protect their properties by:

- Ensuring proper drainage around homes and buildings.
- Installing sump pumps with appropriate outlets and backup protection.
- Keeping catch basins and swales on their property clear of obstructions.

Certain areas of the Township may experience temporary flooding, particularly around ditches, culverts, catch basins, and road crossings. Localized flooding and heavy runoff in fields and low-lying areas are expected but are typically short-term.

If you suspect an issue with a municipal drain on or near your property, please contact the Drainage Department. We will investigate and address any concerns as quickly as possible.
